

OPEN CLASS QUILTS

Please Read

All entrants must read and be familiar with and comply with Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows. General Competition, Rules, Open Class Division General Competition Rules, and any special Division or department competition Requirements or Regulations.

Entry forms are on the tcafas.org website and on Quiltersabovetheclouds.com website.

In Open Class there will be a \$2.00 fee for each Quilt entered

Entry Fees are Non-Refundable

All quilts entered in the 2025 Fair must be completed between August 2020 and July 2025, (5 years) to compete. Quilts that have been previously entered in Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows can <u>NOT</u> be entered again.

Notice to all Quilters – Judging will be held on Wednesday July 30th 2025 at 1:00pm Judging is open to the public

Quilt Judging will <u>not</u> be competing with any other indoor projects, so judging will be more successful and enjoyable event with more opportunity for the community to watch and listen to the judge(s) and ultimately create more interest for the craft of

quilting.

We ask that all attending, *PLEASE* be quiet and be respectful of the judge's time and the information they provide.

<u>PLEASE</u> Silence (ALL) Electronic Devices during the judging.

Questions may be asked *after* the end of Judging.

All Judged Quilts are *final*.

Antique / Vintage Quilts will not be judged. (viewing display only) Must be Entered on Entry form.

<u>Please</u> have your Completed Registration, Fees and your Quilt(s) to the Fair Grounds between **9:00am and 11:00am** on July 30th 2025

Only One Entry Per Class

NO Quilt(s) will be Accepted after 11:15am on July 30th 2025

Judging will start at 1:00pm.

Judging *should* be completed by 5:00pm

Quilts will be hung <u>OR</u> display in viewing cabinets

Quilts will be released at 5:00pm on August 3rd 2025... NO EARLY RELEASES

Quilt(s) <u>MUST</u> be picked up no later than 7:00pm On August 3rd 2025

Quilts will be released from the same building they are received in. Please bring your claim ticket (yellow) to prove entry of ownership when picking up quilt(s). <u>Claim tickets are required for Release of quilt(s)</u>

Colorado Quilting Council *may* provide a special ribbon to one quilt, chosen by the appropriate Colorado Quilting Council Judge on the day of judging. And to the maker having entered the Teller County Association of Fairs and Shows for the first time.

Other Ribbons may be awarded.

First time Ribbons will be awarded to youth under 18 years of age.

Best Of Show Quilt in open and in Youth Division *may* be awarded.
