MARCH: Kathleen Grenfell will do a slide presentation and lecture on her techniques using rulers in long arm quilting. The following day she will offer 2 workshops at the home of MaryAnn Sperry. Space is limited to 6 persons in each group, so sign up early. Cost of the workshop is \$15.

APRIL: Michelle Petsche from Nanas will give a trunk show of her favorite class projects. She will highlight tips and tricks for bag making and quiet books. The workshop the following day has been changed to a fun tote bag called the Teddy Tote. This tote gives a great opportunity to highlight a section of piecing, embroidery or applique. You will want to try all the different versions. Pattern is available at Nanas Quilt Cottage. Cost for the class is only \$20.

MAY: This is the Spring Social and we'll have a program from the Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum about Quilts from the 1930's.

June: Accomplished local artist and quilter Vinda Robison will present her creative process at her lecture with a slideshow. The project is a mini quilt using lots of applications. Cost for the workshop is \$30 + \$5 for the printed pattern. Jill will offer a bonus cardinal class from 9am-12:00 August 26 in the multipurpose room before our guild meeting. Her Cardinal coloring class is always a fun addition to our applique skills. She will bring art supplies to class. No sewing machine is required. Pattern \$5.00. You still need to sign up even though it's a free class. A supply list will be emailed after sign up.

SEPTEMBER: Kate Colleran will be returning for a lecture/trunk show called Slash Your Stash. She has been on a whirlwind ride in the quilting industry since we last saw her. Her class the following day will be an adorable Pumpkin wall hanging with her special techniques in it. She is sending a sample for us to see. Don't miss the chance to learn from this fun and talented instructor. Class is \$20 and pattern is \$12.
